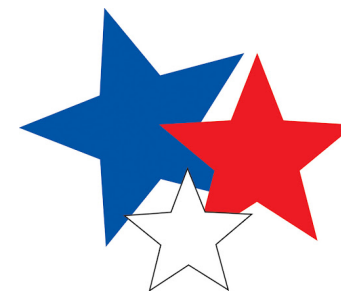




Eagle School Intermediate Parent-School Compact



Teacher/School Responsibilities

- Provide an instructional learning environment where each child can develop his or her individual abilities to the fullest extent to meet the state's challenging student performance standards.
- Provide extended learning opportunities that will help develop individual thinking and reasoning and promote classroom excellence.
- Provide a safe, secure environment conducive to learning in which parents are welcomed to volunteer.
- Provide time to meet with parents to share concerns, and help develop home activities the correlate with school activities.
- Provide frequent feedback to parents concerning their child's performance by updating Schoology weekly.
- Provide opportunities such as conferences, ect. that will enable parents to become involved in their child's learning experiences.

Family Responsibilities

- Require regular school attendance.
- Establish a study time and monitor my child's homework.
- Make every effort to meet with my child's teachers at scheduled sessions and/or before concerns become a problem.
- Read to my child or listen to him or her read to me daily.
- Understand that I am welcome to participate in school activities.
- Connect to Class Dojo and Schoology if internet is available.
- Attend at least one parent teacher conference to discuss my child's progress.
- As my child's first and most important teacher, I will be a positive role model in decision making, manners, respect, and responsible behaviors and encourage my child to model the same.

Student Responsibilities

- Show good manners, respect for self and others, and make responsible choices.
- Gracefully accept the positive or negative outcomes of my choices.
- Lead by example in my attitude and behavior.
- Be prepared for class with necessary supplies and assignments.
- Complete and turn in all class and homework assignments.
- Study and read at home at least ten minutes per grade level, per day.
- Plan study time to avoid conflicts with other activities.
