Communication

- Title I teachers will inform parents of the school's participation in the Title I program and explain the requirements of the program and their right to be involved during the Annual Title I Meeting.
- Teachers will be available for parent/teacher meetings during the Fall and Winter evening parent teacher conferences, as well as, during planning times during the school day as requested. Communication will also be available through Class Dojo and Schoology.
- Teachers and administration will be available upon parental request to discuss decisions related to the education of the child.
- Open communication where parents can freely express ideas, concerns, and improvements to the school-wide program is available during conferences, written communication, and at LSIC meetings.
- Information involving Title I Programs will be distributed via Class Dojo.
- Title I will involve parents in the review and improvement of this policy, the school-parent compact, and the Title I program through surveys and verbal communication.
