Self-Paced, Online Professional Learning Coursework for Certified P-12 West Virginia Educators and Administrators



Earn up to three hours of credit for completion of self-paced, standards-focused courses.

| DATES:

June 1, 2022 – November 20, 2022 (rolling enrollment)

| PROCESS:

- ▶ A Program of Study with three sequential, self-paced courses that provide an in-depth look at the West Virginia College- and Career-Readiness (WVCCR) Standards and alignment with instruction.
- ▶ Each course is worth one-credit hour. Teachers who complete this Program of Study can apply for a total of 3 hours of graduate credit.

| SELF-PACED PROGRAM OF STUDY:

- ▶ Course 1: Grade-level Standards (1 credit hour)
In Course 1, teachers review content standards and deepen their understanding of the differences among standards, curriculum, and instructional resources. Teachers begin to analyze standards and recognize the cognitive performance required of the standards.
- ▶ Course 2: Analyzing Standards (1 credit hour)
In Course 2, teachers continue analyzing standards and develop clear learning targets at multiple levels of Depth of Knowledge that reflect incremental learning toward mastery of WVCCR Standards. Through an intensive examination of standards, teachers develop big ideas and essential questions to guide development of instruction.
- ▶ Course 3: Progression of Standards (1 credit hour)
In Course 3, teachers review standards and trace the development of content and skills across multiple grade levels. As a part of this process, teachers anticipate the just-in-time instructional needs to support students' grade-level learning.

| COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

The courses will require the completion of graphic organizers specific to course content as well as a set of course quizzes and/or course reflections. All quizzes must achieve a score of 100% with multiple attempts allowed.
