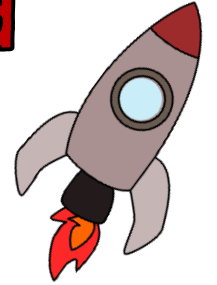

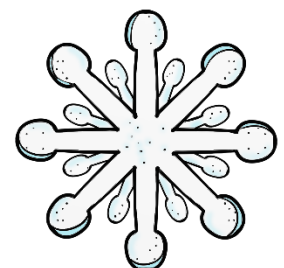

### **Spring Break Announced**

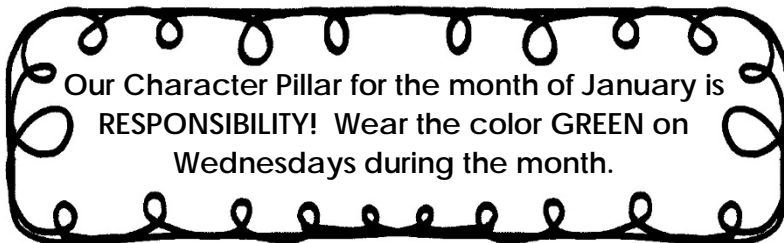
For families who are planning vacations, the dates for Spring Break are Friday, April 14 through Friday, April 21. School resumes on Monday, April 24.

## **Martin's A+ Rewards Update**

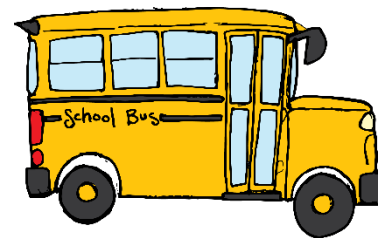
