Master's Programs for Teachers

- **Educational Leadership** – designed for teachers who aspire to take on leadership roles within their schools and districts such as principals, assistant principals, content supervisors, and others.
- **Curriculum and Instruction** – Select from four tracks for advanced training in Teacher Leadership, National Board Certification, Educational Technology, The Elementary STEM Teacher (**NEW**).
- **Special Education** – online program designed to provide teachers with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively meet the needs of special students.
- **Literacy Education (Formerly Reading)** – designed to be highly experiential for developing reading specialists, literary coaches, and reading teachers.
- **School Counseling** – FSU now offers a master's program in school counseling that can be completed on a full or part-time basis. Teachers with a master's degree can also take courses in this program to work toward PPW certification through MSDE.

Master of Arts in Teaching – Elementary and Secondary program for those wanting to become teachers

The Master of Arts in Teaching is a 12-month intensive alternative teacher preparation program designed for career changers or graduates with majors outside of education who would like to teach.
