At Mill Creek Intermediate, we will:

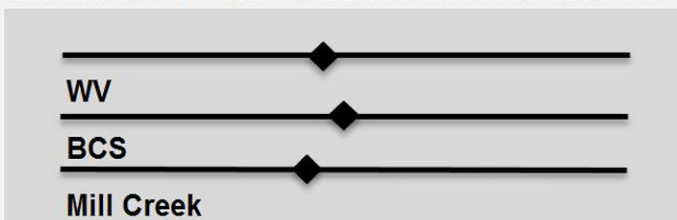

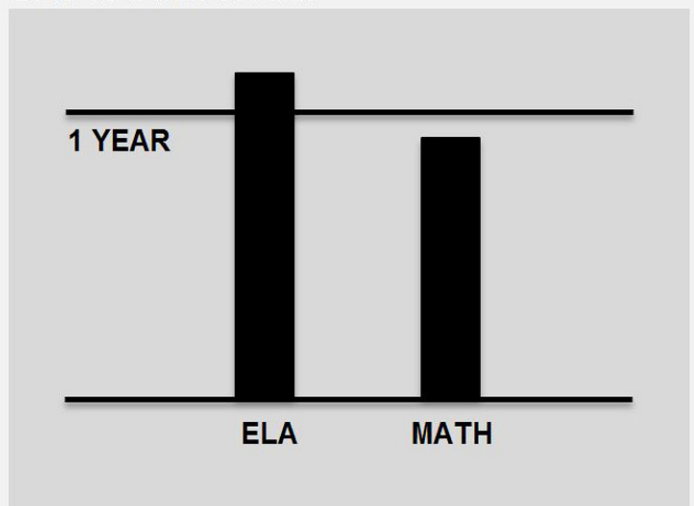
#### Students Proficient in ELA on the 2016 WVGSA
