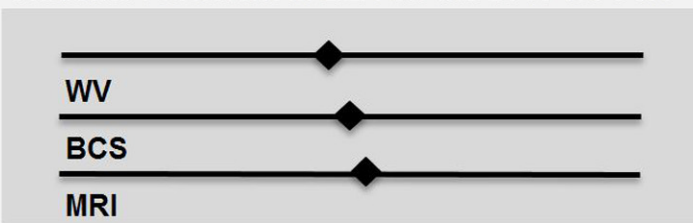
Our School

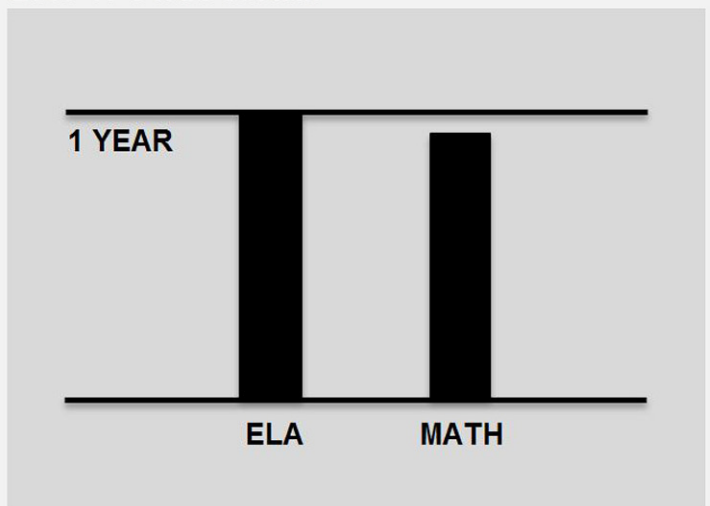
Students Proficient in ELA on the 2016 WVGSA
