#### Vision

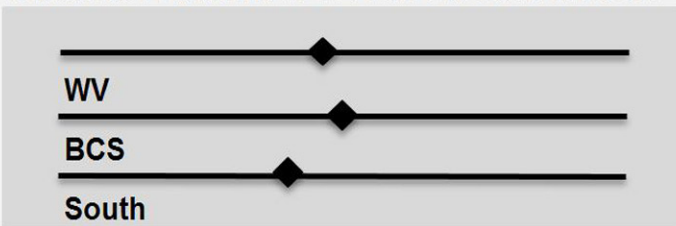

#### Mission

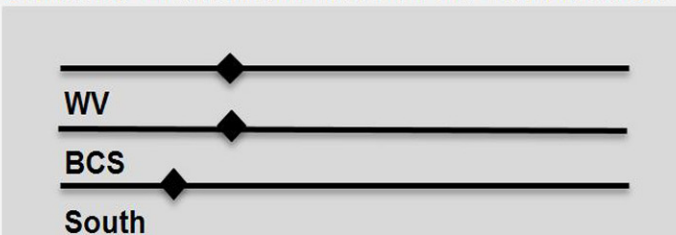
Martinsburg South Middle School's mission is to provide academic excellence in a caring environment, to ensure responsible citizenship in a multicultural society.
